Track One

The 25 excerpts of music on this demonstration recording are in the music education program, Upbeat. Each excerpt will be indentified so that you may use the recording in conjunction with the accompanying notes.

Track Two

From the Preparatory Level (of Upbeat) comes 'Bananas in Pyjamas' to develop a sense of beat.

Music: Bananas in Pyjamas, Preparatory Level Music of the great composers introduces students to artistic landmarks in our musical heritage. Music: Radetzky March, Preparatory Level Pavane pour une infante defunte, Preparatory Level

Traditional songs are treated with new arrangements. Music: As I Was Walking Down the Street, Preparatory Level

Track Three

As students listen to changes in the harmonic texture of music they are presented with good vocal models.

Music: Two In a Boat, Preparatory Level

Track Four

Echo songs, such as 'Candy Man, Salty Dog' lend themselves to vocal improvisations. Music: Candy Man, Salty Dog, Preparatory Level

The formal components of music are introduced through Singing, Moving, Playing, Listening and Creating.

Hearing and interpreting differences in Style are encouraged in songs such as 'Johnny Likes To Do a Dance'.

Track Five

The upper levels of Upbeat introduce musical themes. Music of other cultures is one of the themes of Level Three.

Music: from Africa, India, Australia, Japan, Level Three

In all levels of Upbeat, rhythmic chants and songs lend themselves to d ramatization.

Music: The Goldilocks Rap, Level Three

Track Six

Folk dances and national songs from many different cultures add to the understanding of music of the world.

Music: Hava Nagilah, Level Three Advance, Australia Fair, Level Three

Track Seven Music: The Typewriter, Level Two

Upbeat provides teachers with a wide range of musical styles.

Music: Mozart's Clarinet Concerto in A, Level One All Day, All Night/ Swing Low, Sweet Chariot, Level Four

Track Eight

Jazz is one of the themes of Level Four.

Music: Ya Got Jazz, Level Four

Track Nine

Music: The Three Little Pigs, Level Four Free Form Piece, Level Four Blue Note Scat, Level Four

Free form pieces such as 'Sun Music 1' by Peter Sculthorpe complement the study of other styles.

'Tin Roof Blues', a traditional jazz piece, appears at the end of Level Four. Using a 'call chart'to assist them, students comment on all the musical elements: rhythm, melody, tempo, dynamics, tone colour, texture, form and style.
